- 13. Draft Strategic Plan 2022-2026 (*Minute 90/22 and others*) Further to the previous Council meeting, the draft Strategic Plan 2022-2026 is attached. Once approved it will be professionally designed and published. Regular monitoring reports will be produced *for consideration and approval.*

Plastic Free Community Status As part of the Town Council's commitment to Net Zero Carbon by 2030, the Corsham Climate Action Plan has a target of achieving plastic free community status by the end of 2023. The attached report by the Environmental Project Officer sets out details of the scheme and the requirements for accreditation *for consideration.*
