- 8. 30mph Limits in the Town: At its' meeting on 12 July, Full Council asked for the Property & Amenities Committee to explore which roads would be most suited to a reduction in speed limits from 40mph to 30mph. Subsequent to this, an email was sent to all members of the Property & Amenities Committee, asking them to suggest sections of road for the Committee to consider. The suggestions were as follows:

The A4, up to the end of Copenacre. Bradford Road, up to the five-ways roundabout. Park Lane, to the junction with Westwells Road. Upper Potley. Lypiatt Road, up to the present 30mph limit at Elley Green. Ladbrook Lane (entire). Lacock Road, to the junction with Ladbrook Lane. Silver Street (B3353), between Corsham and Gastard. B3353 at Chapel Knapp.

The Committee is asked to consider these suggestions and to determine which should be sent on to Wiltshire Council with a recommendation that they become 30mph limits. I should be noted that when considering speed limits, Wiltshire Council will consider the following national guidance: www.gov.uk/government/publications/setting-local-speed-limits

 - ii. Services Cotswold Centre, Neston (**copy attached**). Request for a 20mph speed limit.
 - iii. Priory Street, three requests (**copies attached**). Requests for residents parking along Priory Street and/or initiatives to provide affordable commuter parking at car parks.
