7. Community Infrastructure Levy, Review of Wish List and Priorities

Further to previous meetings and since the Corsham Neighbourhood Plan has been made, the wish list of potential Town Council CIL projects has been updated for review.

The updated list (Appendix A – attached) includes a list of completed projects and projects deleted from the list for the reasons stated. Further appendices for background information are: Appendix B - CIL Income and Expenditure Report; Appendix C – Previous CIL List from September 2018; and Appendix D – High Priority CIL Wish List and other major projects. It should be noted that the estimated costs are historic and exclude professional fees.

The Council is asked to consider the updated CIL wish list and agree the priorities. Of the £247,134 CIL money which is currently available, £86,077 had been ringfenced in earmarked reserves towards Public Realm Improvements
