Budget and Precept for 2023/24 With reference to the recent round of committee meetings and the report to the Finance and Administration Committee meeting on 7 December, the draft budget is attached (see DRAFT for 2023/24 column). The Town Council's overall draft budget currently shows an increase in spend of £45,839 with a precept increase of £33,536 (3.07%). However, the increase in the number of Band D Equivalent properties, by 8.43 in 2023/24, reduces the figure to 2.89% per property. The overall Band D Equivalent charge would increase from £220.30 to £226.66 (an increase of £6.36 per year).

Recommendation

It is recommended that the draft budget proposals be approved by the Full Council, with a budget of £1,274,615 and a precept of £1,126,728 for 2023/24.
