Centre for Sustainable Energy: pop over and have a chat with CSE, an independent national charity that shares knowledge and experience to help people change the way they think and act on energy.



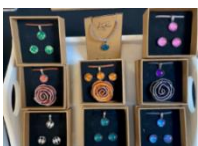

Little Letter Avenue makes wooden toys and décor, sold in eco-friendly packaging. Little Letter Avenue wooden toys are beautifully long lasting, much more durable and sustainable than the plastic equivalents.



Wessex Water are here to share water saving tips, engage with our Corsham customers and share information and advice on using the sewerage system effectively, what households can put down the toilet and the sink for minimal ecological impact, and reusable alternatives.

Seaweed Skirt Craft sells eco-friendly jewellery. Jan is a local crafter of silver and sea glass that she beachcombs from our UK shorelines. The silver is 100% recycled from a UK manufacturer. Jan also uses recycled glass (no plastics) beads and semi-precious gems and stones from broken jewellery.



Eco Fragrances sells eco-friendly home accessories including reed diffusers, wax melts, car diffusers and candles. Eleanor's products are vegan-friendly and cruelty free. The only plastic used is for reed diffuser refills, but this can be recycled. All packaging is reusable, recyclable or biodegradable.

Twig & Leaf sells refillable notebook covers and binders. The refills are glue and plastic free and made from recycled card and board. Wherever possible, Jude sources components from the UK, including eco board, adhesives and papers.
